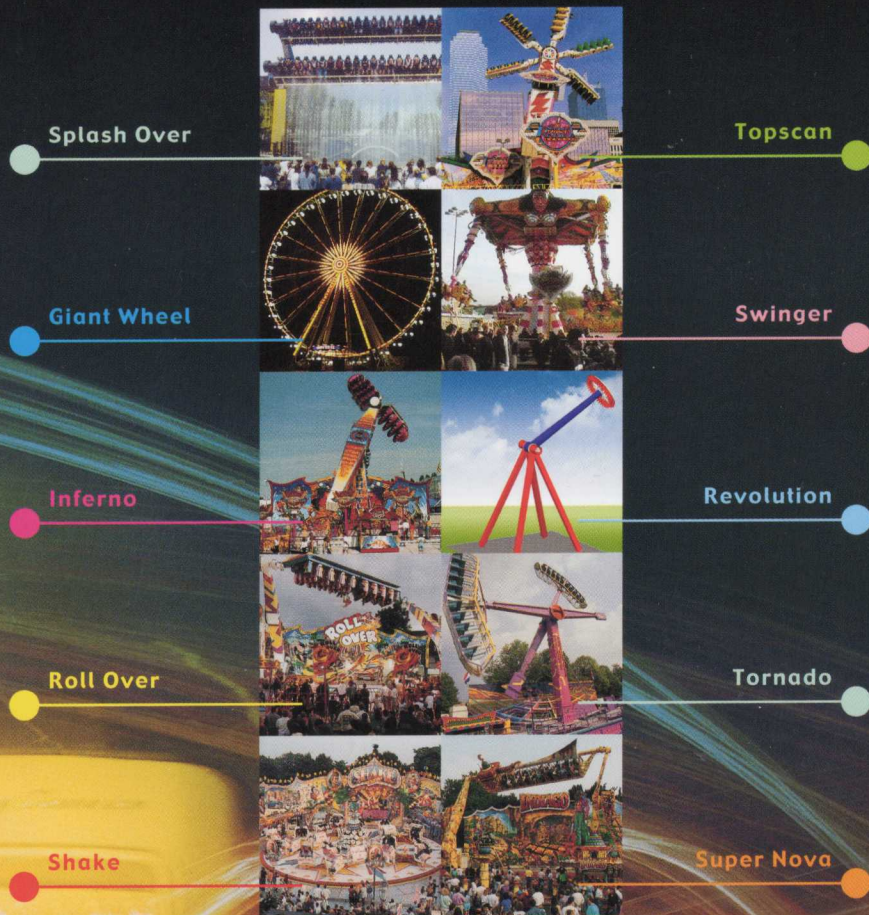




World of Rides



Splash Over

Two forks rotating with two free moving gondola's which can go over the top. Moving upside down towards the pool, with the fountains that almost catch you in their water spray. Almost?..... well during hot weather things sometimes suddenly change!! The free moving gondola's, the programmable fountains and the "looks" of this machine make it an absolute must for every amusement park.

Giant Wheel

Giant Wheels are always a very popular addition to parks and midways. The Mondial Compact System Giant Wheels which combine a small footprint with a maximum height and a minimum of erection and dismantling time (up to 51 meters high) as well as the park versions (up to 130 meters high) are simply the best.

Inferno

The Inferno is an impressive machine and its movements are very thrilling and smooth. The drive enables the main cross arm to make an oval arc in both directions. At the end of this cross arm are two rotating gondola's, which together have the appearance of a big boat. The gondola's rotate independently of the other. The Inferno gives its passenger a sensational but safe ride.

Roll Over

This amusement ride achieves a sensational combination of ride effects, it makes pendulum-, swinging around- and vertical circular movements. It is also possible thanks to a built in braking system in the rigid arm, to bring it to an upside down position, also enabling to perform a looping, no matter in which position, even in a slanting one. The arms of the Roll Over can turn independent of each other.

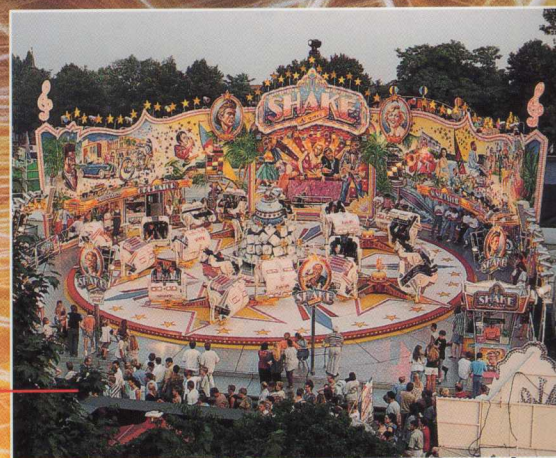

Shake

This breathtaking round ride is an attractive eye catcher. The rotations of the platform are variable. There are five cross arms on the platform which rotate contra to the platform. Four gondola's are suspended from each cross arm. The gondola's rotate independently of each other, swing freely and roll over. The Shake is available as a park or as a portable ride built on a trailer. Special back-walls and even a roof are also available.

Swinger

This family ride combines the rotating movements of a carousel with the pendulum movements of a swing. This results in a smooth but also exciting ride experience with unlimited variations. The Swinger is more than a ride, it is real entertainment due to the almost unlimited possibilities. The Swinger is also available with learning controls for easy programming.

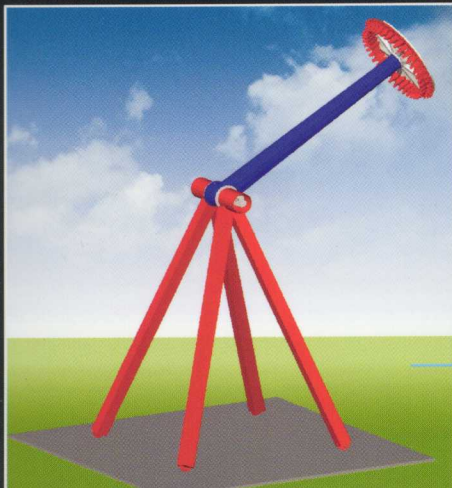

Super Nova

The Super Nova is an attractive amusement ride. The arms can turn independent of each other. The gondola swings and at the same time assumes an angle of up to approx. 80 to 90 degrees. The Super Nova is a very special family ride. The operator can adjust the level of sensation to the age of the passengers he has on board.

Revolution

This giant swing is a sensation to ride and to look at. The rotating disk with the passengers seated on the outside swings up to 35 meters high up to an angle of 120 degrees. 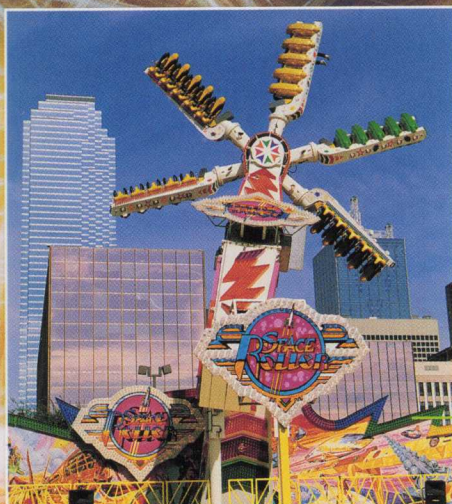

With one gondola moving clockwise and the other moving counter clockwise, this machine is also very attractive for the people who are not brave enough to enter this ride.

Topscan

The Topscan is a really magnificent attraction, which offers a smooth and thrilling experience. The drive enables the main cross arm to make an oval arc in both directions. At the end of this cross arm are the rotating gondolas, which are fitted with the safest shoulder and lap restraints. The gondolas are allowed to rotate freely using centrifugal force. As the rider's legs are free the sensation of flying and performing loops is enhanced.

Giant Wheels

Mondial developed the Mondial Compact System (MCS) which has lot of advantages for a traveling machine:

1. Trailers are integrated in the basis of the Giant Wheel.
2. No big crane needed for erection.
3. Fewer personnel needed.
4. Less erection and dismantling time.
5. Small footprint.

Mondial also has a wide range of park models up to 130 meters high (which of course is not an absolute maximum).
